

EAT HALAAL AND SPEAK THE TRUTH

Globalisation has transformed the nature of day-to-day living. Getting from Point A to Point B previously took days on end, now it spans just a few hours. Communication across the globe happens up to the minute, if not to a portion of a second. Cultures and norms of peoples from the furthest corners of the earth are now becoming fused into each other. Life is fast and instant gratification is abuzz.

While there may be many positive spin offs of this phenomenon, many varieties, forms and shapes of consumables are now available in the market place. This is now more prevalent than ever before. It requires a person, more so a Muslim, to be more wary and prudent in the choices he / she makes.

Decades ago, the concept of Halaal in the mind of the ordinary Muslim was confined

to meat and probably a few confectioneries. One of the greatest achievements of the Halaal regulatory organisations, and Halaal Department (HD) in particular, is the consciousness of Halaal consumption. Muslims are increasingly probing the suitable nature of cosmetics, toiletries, medication, and even down to a toothpick. All praise is due to Allah, the Almighty.

Halaal is an integral part of the life of a Muslim. Not only it is a direct command of Allah mentioned in the Noble Qur'an, but it also has a very strong link with virtuous deeds. The acceptance of supplication and prayer depends squarely upon the type of food that enters one's body. It is on the basis of this bond that many a pious people have noted: "In accordance with the proportion of Halaal a person consumes,

likewise will be the inclination and pleasure derived in performing good deeds."

Among many questions exchanged between Rasulullah and Ali radhiyallahu 'anhu, in a lengthy conversation as recorded in Tafseer An-Nasafi, Ali radhiyallahu 'anhu asked: "What can I do for my salvation?" Rasulullah sallallahu 'alayhi wasallam replied: "Eat Halaal and speak the truth."

Behind the scenes, there are many who tirelessly put shoulder to wheel ensuring that Muslims are able to place in their mouths those things which will secure the Pleasure of Allah in their favour. Despite the continuous onslaught of negativity and hurling of attacks, HD has steadfastly risen above the wave and provided a sterling service to the Ummah.

CONFORMITY OF FOODS TO HALAAL

Most foods and drinks are considered Halaal except that which have been prohibited by a Quranic verse or an authentic Hadith. Any food or drink that does not fall into the forbidden (Haraam) is considered lawful (Halaal). It is a responsibility of a Muslim to check and judge the permissible and the prohibitive nature of all foods and drinks before consumption. Every food and drink to be consumed should confirm to Halaal standards.

Muslims are neither to be misled by others, nor by their own appetites unchecked by knowledge. They are to select or reject food or drink according to teachings of Islam in complete obedience to their Lord - Allah." But many do mislead (men) by their appetite unchecked by knowledge. Your Lord knows the best those who

transgress." Al-Quran (6:119)

It is therefore very important that every Muslim should have the knowledge of the forbidden (Haraam) categories of food and drinks. Once a Muslim is equipped with this knowledge, he can totally avoid Haraam things and safeguard his religion and honour. As far as the Makrooh (discouraged) things are concerned Muslims are recommended to avoid them it is an act of piety. Regarding Mashbooh (suspected) things, Muslims are to further investigate them in the light of contemporary knowledge until an answer is found. In the meantime, however, the recommendation is: `when in doubt leave it out.`

DINING WHERE LIQUOR IS SERVED

Liquor and other intoxicants are totally prohibited in Islam - Haraam - at every level from production, trade and consumption. These prohibitions and injunctions are sanctioned by the creator himself backed up by the teachings of the Prophet (選) (Q5:90). Despite this, yet we find that many are increasingly becoming desensitized to frequenting places and gatherings which do fragrantly violate the laws of Allah.

Sayyiddina Umar (Allah pleased with him) narrated that he heard the Messenger of Allah (鑑) saying "(WHOEVER BELIEVES IN ALLAH AND THE LAST DAY, MUST NOT SIT AT THE TABLE AT WHICH KHAMR (LIQOUR IS SERVED)." (Reported by Ahmed.)

When Umar bin Abdul Aziz (Allah's mercy be upon him) was Governor of Al-Madinah for Banu Umayyad and later Khalifah of the Muslims, some people were arrested for consuming liquor and Umar (RA) sentenced them to be lashed. When someone defended one of them that he was fasting and did not drink, Umar (RA) confirmed the lashing on him as well by reciting.

"It has been revealed in the book that when you hear the signs of Allah denied and mocked at: that you should not sit with them until they change to some other speech, or else you are like them. Indeed Allah will gather the hypocrites and disbelievers together in hell. (Quran 4:140)

This person who was fasting was lashed as well because he did not show any concern sitting with people who were drinking liquor. This happens in our towns and cities where we get Muslims patronizing places that sell

beer with perception that their food is Halaal. And other Muslim owned places with all endeavors of selling Halaal food yet they have a bar serving beer on a certain corner.

This all, is unacceptable. whether the bar corner is run by any other person or themselves. By the fact that it is within a Muslim campus and due to the fact that one is not concerned with presence of beer — something which Allah has Forbade- is a very serious issue on one's faith.

This is the reason why the Halaal Department is certifying even a vegetarian restaurant because the chances of contamination can't be ruled out in areas of marinating sea food in white wine. Use of basting brushes made of pig bristle use of gelatin from non-Halaal slaughtered animals, etc.

The Prophet (ﷺ) said; "whoever among you sees an evil action, let him change it with his hand (by taking action). If he can not, then with his tongue (by speaking out) if he can not, then with his heart (by hating it and feeling that it is wrong) and that is the weakest of faith (narrated by Muslim).

This denunciation of the heart is an individual's obligation in all situations and there is no excuse as no one has any power over your heart. Staying in a place where evil is being committed goes direct against this. No matter which ever way you serve it, dining where liquor is served is harmful to your Imaan.

Halaal & Kosher

Are they interchangeable and exchangeable?

Muslims accept as sacrosanct the role of all the previous Prophets (A.S.) and the Scriptures with ultimate reliance on the final verse of the Final Revelation revealed to the Last Prophet (ﷺ).

The verse states" ... this day have I perfected your religion for you and completed my favour upon you and chosen for you Islam as your religion." (Surah 5, Verse 3)

Despite this irrevocable determinate, some believe that Kosher equates to Halaal and one can switch from one to the other when a "need" arises. Whilst there are commonalities and linguistic similarities in that Kosher is a Hebrew word that means "proper or fit" and Halaal is an Arabic word that means "permissible," they are different entities in both meaning and spirit.

While it is known that pork and pork products are unacceptable for both, there are many differences that one may not be aware of such as: –

- 1. Islam prohibits all intoxicants while liquor in general is regarded as Kosher. Grape-derived wines can also be Kosher if manufactured under the supervision of a Rabbi. The Kosher mark cannot make it Halaal.
- 2. Gelatin is considered Kosher by some Jewish authorities regardless of the source of origin. Muslims consider gelatin prepared from pork and non-Halaal slaughtered animal origin as Haraam. Therefore, food items such as marshmallows,

- yoghurts etc. are not automatically considered Halaal with a Kosher symbol.
- 3. Enzymes irrespective of their source are acceptable in cheese making and carry the Kosher symbol, whilst enzymes of pork origin are Haraam.
- 4. Jewish law permits use of pig-hair basting brushes in food preparation whilst it is Haraam for Muslims.
- Pig skin products may be used by Jews whilst it is forbidden for Muslims.
- 6. Islam considers the entire carcass of permitted animals as Halaal whilst Jews cannot consume the hind quarter.
- 7. Jewish law requires recitation of a prayer at the beginning of the slaughter day while it is mandatory in Islam to pronounce the name of Allah on the slaughter of each animal.
- 8. For those who erroneously believe that Halaal equates to Kosher and vice versa and hence interchangeable and exchangeable, Jewish dietary law is explicit in not accepting Halaal as Kosher.

The Divine laws of Islam are indeed perfect as taught to us by the perfect Exemplar, the Noble Prophet (ﷺ). Consumption of Halaal is a key to one's Salvation.



SOME IMPORTANT CRITERIA TO OBTAIN HD'S CERTIFICATE

All Halaal requirements set by HD must be met before submitting a formal application.

If the establishment is a fast-food chain store or operates under a franchise scheme, it must submit an application for each individual outlet to be approved as Halaal by HD, as well as the central kitchen and main stores.

There must be at least one HD Muslim Supervisor involved in the production or preparation of Halaal products or foods. Their full-time presence is vital in maintaining HD's standards and helping to continually verify all Halaal food sources. They must also be involved in the receiving of Halaal food or meat supplies. They must have the right to inspect all relevant documentation in respect of the same.

Only Halaal food approved by HD are to be served, sold, stored and/or processed exclusively separate from the rest of the other foods which are Haraam such as pork and its by-products and alcohol.

Qualified Muslims in accordance with the uniform standards set out by the Shariah and understood by the HD must slaughter all meat and all poultry used.

All Halaal certificates (other than HD's) relied upon by the

applicant with respect to imported meat, poultry or the by-products of the same must be issued by those Islamic authorities approved by HD.

All animal-based ingredients must be derived from a Halaal source approved by HD.

Halaal foods should not in the course of preparation, processing, transportation or storage be in contact with non-Halaal foods. Cross contamination must be avoided at all times.

All crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils and equipment, chillers, freezers and cold-rooms must be cleansed under the supervision of HD's appointed official(s) if they have been used previously for preparing foods with pork or other Haraam products.

Crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils and equipment for Halaal foods must be separated from those for non-Halaal foods.

Separate washing and drying equipment for such items must be provided.

Staff must not be allowed to bring non-Halaal foods and beverages into the Halaal certified places.

HALAAL IN BOARDING SCHOOLS

Islam is a complete way of life and one of the commandments which a Muslim has to live by, is to consume Halaal.

The Halaal Department of Muslim Association of Malawi has over the last twenty years made great strides in making sure that Halaal food is available in our local markets. It has also certified many establishments ranging from food manufacturers, processors, bakery and confectioneries, restaurants as well butcheries. All this is to make sure that the Muslim community is served with Halaal food.

The demand for Halaal food in the Country is increasing every day to the extent that even non-Muslims are demanding it. This is because people are now understanding the benefits of Halaal food in human body.


Much as we appreciate the effort made by the Halaal Department as well as the Muslim community in the country in as far as Halaal Food is concerned, the challenge remains to the youth who are in Boarding Schools. As a Muslim student at the public or private university, college, secondary school or primary school, do you know the Halaal status of the food you are taking every day from your institution? Have you ever asked the authorities as to where their meat / chicken related products are getting from? Have you ever inspected their central kitchen?

To have Halaal food is a human right for Muslims therefore it has to be demanded at all cost. Some of the Muslim students do abstain from eating meat related products at their respective boarding schools just because they don't know the Halaal status of those products. This cannot solve the


problem because you are paying for that meat. As a Muslim student, you should not underrate yourself, you might be in minority at the institution but you can make a difference. No matter how small in number you are, you deserve Halaal food because that is what your Rabb (Allah) has commanded you. Mind you, Islam is not about quantity but quality. Whether you are a female or a male Muslim student at a public or private university or a secondary school always make sure that you are preserving your Imaan that is by eating Halaal food only.


You have been selected to an Educational institution out of thousands of students in the country, what does that mean to you? Is it by fluke? or by chance? Not at all, it is by the will of Allah the Creator. Your Imaan (faith) should not be compromised just because you want to pursue worldly education. One of the conditions for your Dua to be accepted by Allah is that your food / drinks should always be Halaal, therefore the issue of Halaal food must be taken seriously like any other Ibadaat (worship) before Allah.

Having made your individual effort at the institution in as far as Halaal food is concerned, you can now consult the Halaal Department for products verification and certification since it is the only Organisation in Malawi mandated to certify food products. If the Halaal Department certifies a café or a restaurant at your institution then you are now assured that everything prepared from that restaurant is Halaal. You can comfortably eat and drink anything from the restaurant or café.



Producing Halaal Gelatin Is not rocket science...!

Modernity which belongs to the West invented countless numbers of industrial foods and is now trying to convince us that the gelatin that is used in those artificial foods is Halaal. Businessmen and their technical staff from medicine, cosmetics and food industries get together with modern some religion-mongers and they all rant and rave claiming that their Gelatin is Halaal. Some of them stick to the Islamic principle of necessity (Zarurah), some claim it is Transformation (Istihala), some say it is Umum ul Balwah (unfavorable widespread situation difficult to control). As expected, a few of them claim that all their products are Halaal. Alas, they all know that they stick to unacceptable excuses. When they look at any reliable Figh source, they will not be able to find any Fatwah or technical information that will support their makeshift claims.

However, producing Halaal Gelatin is not rocket science. Millions of Muslim ladies produce Halaal Gelatin every day at their kitchens. They put Halaal slaughtered meat in their pots and cook it. At the end of cooking process, the gelatin permeates to the juice of the food. This is so easy. It is also the same process in the industry. You only need Halaal raw material, heat and water. That is all. The key issue is that the raw materials must be obtained only from Halaal sources.

Let's explain the raw material: Bodies of all living creatures are made mostly of proteins. Proteins are made of different amino acids. Different numbers of compositions of amino acids form different protein groups. The protein group that can form the gelatin is called Collagen. When this protein contacts hot water, it hydrolyses, loses its molecular ties and permeates to water. When water is boiled and vaporized, the residue is gelatin. To lower the cost of gelatin, bones and hides of animals are used.

Of course, the industry uses big tanks of 100 or 150 tons to produce the gelatin. The raw materials are actually the wastes like skins, bones, parts from slaughter houses and leather processing plants. Process is multi-phase: heating, soaking, evaporation, drying and grinding. As mentioned above, the most important issue is to ensure that all parts of raw materials must come from Halaal sources. This means that raw materials cannot come from Haraam animals like pork and all parts must come from animals that are slaughtered as per Islamic principles and rules.

It is a common knowledge that more than 70% of gelatin is from pork. Today, 380,000 tons of gelatin is produced every year. 99% of this quantity is produced in non-muslim countries. In such a case, it is very normal to expect that almost all of the gelatin comes either from pork, or from animals that are not slaughtered in the Islamic way. Unfortunately, even 1000 tons of gelatin is NOT produced as Halaal and Tayyib.

Turkey imports about 6000 tons of gelatin and Muslims worldwide consume half of the gelatin produced.

<u>Gelatin is everywhere:</u> in food, medicines, cosmetics and industry. But these Muslim businessmen who use enormous amounts of gelatin without hesitation have not even attempted to establish a plant that will supply Halal gelatin. Instead, they continue to find ways to feed Muslims with doubtful or Haraam products obtained from Haraam or doubtful sources. This is a worrying situation.
