THE DIVINE COMMANDMENTS OF HALAAL

Allah Almighty says: "O you People! Eat of what is on earth, Halaal and pure, and do not follow the footsteps of the Satan; Indeed, for he is to you an open enemy". (2:168)

Indeed, the very act of consuming Halaal is a testimony to our belief in Allah Almighty and his revelation and laxity in this regard places a serious question on our sincerity and belief.

Allah Almighty says: "Eat of that (meat) over which the Name of Allah Almighty has been pronounced (while slaughtering that animal/bird), if you are believers in His Revelations". (6:118)

Eating Halaal is not only fulfilling a divine commandment, but also a source of great blessing that will make good deeds easier for us, allow our Dua to be answered and save us

from the Hell fire. On the contrary, the Ahadith are clear that those who are not conscientious of what they eat and stray into Haraam, will have Duas rejected even if they are in an otherwise pitiable and humbled state.

Despite these clear injunctions and benefits of Halaal food and the severe consequences of being lax in this regard, many today have become living fulfilments of the description This may not be overt, but our eating decisions often beg the question of whether we really care what we put into our mouths.

The modern world is a confusing and complicated place and although the laws and boundaries of Halaal and Haraam are clearly defined, food products nowadays abound with doubtful, hidden ingredients and

E-codes. Yet, following our desires and taste buds, many of us choose to take the risk, wavering into those grey areas that will eventually lead us to Haraam. (May Allah Almighty protect us)

The utility and value of organizations such as HD in this kind of world is unquestionable. Questions and Answers Segment

Q. If we visit a Muslim's house for food, should we enquire regarding the Halaal aspect of the food? What about when we purchase food?

A. The default position is that a Muslim should trust another Muslim particularly if he has been invited for food. However, if one has a genuine basis for doubt e.g. suspects his friend's statement on reasonable grounds, for example, he has himself seen him purchasing the meat from a non-Muslim dealer who deals in Haraam meat, or he has found him too careless in these matters to be relied upon, then he should not rely on his statement except after enquiry.

The same principle applies when purchasing food, however, the importance to enquire when purchasing in the current era is greater, due to the nature of the global food market, the prevalent dubious practices and the low levels of Taqwa

Q. Why Halaal food matters?

A. The most important reason to consume Halaal is to obey Allah's commands. In addition, as your Creator and the Creator of the whole universe, He knows what is best for you. Halaal food being free from harmful and filthy substances is not just vital for the body but also for the mind. Our thoughts are impacted by the kind of food we eat. Gary L. Wenk stated in his article, 'How does food affect our brain?' "Almost everything you choose to consume will directly or indirectly affect your brain." So, imagine eating meat which comprises of blood, bacteria and other harmful substances and its impact on our thoughts.

Q. Are insects Halaal food?

A. According to Islamic law, all insects are Haraam except for the locusts. Ahmed and others narrated that the Prophet Muhammad said 2 things are allowed to eat even if they are dead, Locusts and fish.

Q. I would like to know if one is permissible to use soap, colognes and perfumes containing alcohol.

A: In general, use of perfumes, soap and colognes is Halaal (permissible). And the same ruling applies for body lotions that contain alcohol. The alcohol used in creams/ cosmetics e.tc. are denatured (methylated spirits), they are not from "Khamr-asli" categorically which is najis (impure).

Q: If I eat Halaal food does that make me Muslim?

A: No. Eating Halaal food does not make one to become Muslim but it is one of Allah's commands to Muslims. But due to widespread scare in the markets regarding food safety and security such as the threat of disease, there is strong evidence that Non-Muslims also now prefer Halaal foods for additional safety, hygiene and quality assurance features. They believe that the production of Halaal foods, requires strict monitoring from point of production to the point of sale.

Q: Is Steers and Debonairs Restaurant in Blantyre near Ryalls Hotel Halaal Certified?

A: This Restaurant is not approved Halaal by the Halaal Department because pork is served. Kindly take not that Halaal certified places can be identified by always looking for HD logo and valid Halaal Certificate.

Q: I would like to know why Cadbury products are Halaal even though they do not have Halaal logo on their products.

A: Indeed, Cadbury South Africa's products are NOT Certified Halaal by any Halaal body. Whereas Cadbury has revealed ingredient formulations etc. of products to South African National Halaal Authority (SANHA) and if no concerns are found in the formulations, HD has deemed such products as Halaal.

Q: Are Mount Soche and Ryalls Hotels Halaal certified?

A: Mount Soche and Ryalls Hotels are NOT Halaal Certified by HD. Kindly note: HD does NOT Certify Eateries that serve alcohol and Pork. Currently, HD has certified the following Hotels; Hotel Victoria, Malawi Sun Hotel, both Crossroads Hotels of Blantyre and Lilongwe.

Q: How trustworthy in certification is Halaal Department?

A: HD's inception in Malawi was in 1994 and it got registered in 1996 as official Halaal Certifying Authority in Malawi under the mandate of Muslim Association of Malawi (MAM). Since then HD's system in certifying food industry has been unique up to date. The system of deploying Muslim Supervisors in Halaal certified establishments is a mark of excellence by Halaal Certifying bodies internationally.

The guidelines of Halaal Department are drawn by reliable Ulama (Muslim Theologians) over the country. These leading Ulama are decision makers of HD. They provide guidance in all matters pertaining to the general application of the term Halaal in food Industry in conformity with the Muslims Dietary Laws (Shariah) Sheikh Muhammad Muaaz Nadwi and Sheikh Muhammad Silika are the current signatories of HD Certificate.

HD has established committees in various Districts and Municipalities in the country. Their main duty is to back up HD inspectors in Halaal related issues in the districts/ municipalities.

HD follows strictly guidelines stipulated by Shariah. As a way of insuring that no discrepancies are committed in the process, and to make sure that the system is 100% full proof, HD applies total supervision from point of production to the point of sell.

Q: Some products are just written the word "Halaal" on them without Halaal Department Logo. Can we trust and consider such products as Halaal?

A: Those businesses and companies who write Halaal word on their products they do so illegally without HD's consent and without any credibility. Please note: In buying processed foods, give priority on products with Halaal Logo of the certifying Body. Do not be fooled with products written the word "Halaal" on their labels. This can be fake. Be sure that the Halaal logo is of genuine Halaal Certifying body. Take note of the certifying body, it must be accredited worldwide to insure reliability of its Certification. On this, HD would like to remind everyone that the word Halaal'/ 'Halal'/ 'Halal' is registered trade mark of Halaal Department of Muslim Association of Malawi. No one has the right to use it without its consent.

Q: Is Super Maheu made by Chibuku products Halaal Certified?

A: The product in question is NOT Halaal Certified by HD. The only Maheu Certified Halaal by HD is Yoza Maheu produced by Suncrest Creameries Ltd.

Q: I heard that white sugar contains animal bones which is responsible for the white color. Those bone may not be Halaal (If the animal was killed in un-Islamic way) so, is sugar Halaal?

A: In Malawi, the only sugar manufacturing company that HD has certified Halaal is Illovo Sugar Mw Ltd and their sugar is not made out of nor does it contains animal bones. Further refinement is what gives it that white color and shine. This is done through the use of Halaal approved chemicals.

Q: How can I get Halaal Department Certificate for my Business?

Step 1: Application

A: You must apply to Halaal Department. In the application letter you must state type of business you are applying for and where the business is run from. The applicant must be willing to comply to HD.

Step 2: Audit

Once the application information is verified, initial inspection shall be conducted by officials from Halaal Department to the business.: Normally 3 visits are enough. The Auditors will inspect and verify the following areas and advise accordingly:

- Product's Raw Materials sources
- List of products
- Halaal supported Documentation
- · Processing and handling
- · Storage, display and product serving
- · Cleanliness, sanitary and food safety
- . The overall aspects of the premises
- · Packaging and labelling

During the audit, the business may provide criteria of acceptance of raw materials (ingredients), certificate of analysis and Halaal certificate of individual ingredient. Once, the audit is completed, an audit report will be prepared and sent to HD operations team.

Step 3: Certification

Once the Halaal audit is complete, HD operations team calls for Muslim Theologians meeting. If the audit report is satisfactory and the business meets HD's certification criteria's, the Ulama approves it Halaal Certification of that particular business. From there, Memorandum of Understanding to sign, and issuing of Certificate. Then the business shall be intitled to use HD signage.

O: Is Kombucha Halaal Certified?

A: This product is NOT Halaal Certified by HD as it contains alcohol.

Q: Could you please list down Quranic verses that mention about Halaal and Haraam food?

A: The verses are: Quran 2 verse 173, Quran 5 Verse 3, Quran 5 Verse 4, Quran 5 Verse 90 and Quran 6 Verse 118.



Q: I read from one of HD's posters that toothbrushes made from animal hair are Haraam. Could you clarify?

A: Yes, brushes on the market are made with pig bristles. Muslims regard pigs to be impure as well as pork and its by- products are Haraam (forbidden) to use. Kindly be advised to always look for brushes made with nylon. However, it is not easy to determine the Halaal status form of brushes that are made from animal hair. The only way that you will know is by testing on the bristles on fire lightly. If hairy smell is produced, then you will know that it made with animal hair and it should be condemned.



CHALLENGES FACING THE HALAAL CONSUMPTION IN MALAWI AND SUGGESTED SOLUTIONS

Introduction: The concept of Halaal is an absolute concern to the Muslim consumption which there adheres to the prescribed value system stipulated by the Islamic Shariah (Laws) which comprises the permissible and prohibition. Basically, Halaal is associated with food products, however, it is more than just about food. Muslims in Malawi and around the world are known to be obligated to incorporate Halaal food in their diet. The products consumed by the Muslim consumer must be free from the contamination of Haram or unlawful substances.

1. Halaal Logo issue

One of the most vital elements of Halaal food packaging is the Halaal logo. Consumers rely heavily on the Halaal label on the product package as it communicates important cues of the Halaal suitability of the product. There are cases of some food operators displaying various type of private Halaal logo at their premises with the intention of misleading the Muslim consumer and enticing them to frequenting their premises. Some companies mischievously misuse the Halaal logo so as to avert the consumer.

2. Literature Review:

Suspiciousness of the ingredient used in their product. Surprisingly, there are also some cases in which the consumers are doubtful of the authenticity of the Halaal logo on the food packaging, despite the fact that it is accredited by a distinguished authority. Consequently, consumers, particularly some Muslims are skeptical over the credence of the Halaal logo used by the manufacturer.

3. Misconception of the product origin

Another possible issue encountered by the consumer of Halaal product is attributed to the products' origin. Muslim consumers are most cautious when choosing and buying food product. They prefer to purchase and consume Halaal food product from their own country or other countries with predominant Muslims population. Therefore, consumers tend to be skeptical of food products imported from non-Muslim countries such as China. This can lead to the misunderstanding of the consumer believing that countries related with Islamic religion may produce the most of the Halaal product.

4. Labeling issue:

Misuse of Islamic images and terms on product packaging. Consumers are also being deceived by words used on the product packaging. There are some products in the market that used Arabic words to deceive the Muslim consumers. Furthermore, some consumers take for granted the Halaal word or the Halaal logo without questioning their authenticity. The consequences of the labelling exploitation can lead to confusion among the Muslim consumers.

5. Halaal Literacy

Another major issue that requires earnest attention is pertaining to the Halaal literacy of the consumer. Some consumers' understanding, awareness, and familiarity with the food they consumed are built upon many factors that consist of personal sentiment, societal, and other environmental factors. There is a pocket of resistance among some of the consumer because they misunderstand the true meaning of Halaal. Some of them tend to associate Halaal with religious ritual, especially the slaughtering. For this reason, the consumers feel unpleasant towards the product claimed to be Halaal, due to the lack of knowledge on this subject. The universal concept of Halaal in food production holds the idea of being clean, healthy, and free from any kind of contamination.

Solutions

- 1. Consumers are encouraged to seek accurate and latest information on the Halaal matter through a proper channel to understand it better in the context of food product.
- Companies must strongly be encouraged to provide a clear and standardize labelling on the Halaal product to avoid confusion among the consumers.
- 3. Although it might be true that Islamic countries do have a close indication to produce Halaal products, yet it depends on the manufacturer that produced the product.
- 4. In order to guide the consumer on buying a Halaal product, the product packaging must consist of the name or brand name and address of manufacturer or distributor, list of ingredients, code number representing production batch, and manufacturing and expiry date as well as the Halaal logo from recognized Halaal Authority. All of this information must be legitimate.
- 5. To avoid the misinterpretation of issue related to the Halaal market, Muslims and the general public need to work together through the establishment of consumer interest groups. In this context, communication plays a vital role in reaching out to the consumer.
- 6. Consumer should crosscheck the information about Halaal with a legitimate source. Relevant authorities are obligated to ensure the dissemination of information. The information should be made clear and easily comprehensible to the Muslim and non-Muslim consumer.
- 7. Another essential recommendation is by labelling the non-Halaal product with a proper non-Halaal label as this can help the consumer to make a proper choice for their purchase. This initiative signifies business entities that are reliable and sensible towards the consumer need.
